SHISHU ANANTA MAHAVIDYALAYA,BALIPATNA ANNUAL REPORT FOR THE SESSION:2023-24

Shishu Ananta Mahavidyalaya was established in the year 1978, named after "Shishu Ananta Das" the great devotional poet of the area. It is also the birth place of poet "Jayadev" famous for "Geeta Govinda". It is situated in Balipatna block in Jaydev Assembly Constituency. Our college is rural based institution which is a premier institution of Jayadev constituency. It was established with a mission to provide equal education in order to enable the students to meet the challenges of globalised world of 21st century. The institution also inspires among the students a genuine sense of equality, social justice, rationalism, secularism & national integration and also encourage them to be catalyst in the socio-economic and cultural transformations. The pioneers of the institution also started the institution not only to develop the academic skills but also to develop the co-curricular activities with a spiritual, ethical and moral values.

As the institution is situated in the rural area, most of the parents of the students are dependent to agriculture also in the mark of poverty line. To facilitate an easy, need based and quality education to these students, the institution collects an affordable admission/academic fee which is less in comparison to other neighbouring institutions.

The institution runs with a composite status imparting quality education to students of both Higher Secondary and Degree Wings (Arts, Science and Commerce). The administration of this institution is frequently monitored by the Governing Body headed by President (Sub-Collector Bhubaneswar) and Secretary as Principal of the Institution. During this year our institution runs with 34 teaching faculty members and 19 non-teaching members.

Transparent e-admission procedure is adopted through Student Academic Management System (SAMS). During this academic year in the degree wing 1017 students were admitted in our college through admission of new batch and re-admission of existing batch. Also 329 students successfully completed their Under Graduation Course during this year.

The teachers and students avail a better learning process through the college which have a good number of books (out of total 15669 books 12484 are text books, 3185 are reference books and 2214 journals and magazines). The spacious reading room also helps the students to read magazines and daily news papers regularly.

The institution always tries to enrich the inherent qualities of the students by organising various co-curricular activities such as seminars, sports and cultural activities.

It is a matter of great pride that not only the students but also all the staff members have successfully completed assigned task to them in an effective and efficient manner. In this context programme under NSS wing "PATHA PRANTA NATAK" on the theme of prohibition of child's marriage, taking care of old age parents, protection of monuments, new plantation programme to keep the surroundings safe from the effect of carbon dioxide and the programme to increase the awareness of the community about the "ROAD SAFETY" like wearing helmets, not to use mobile phone during the time of driving and not to consume alcohol.

NUA-Odisha programme sponsored by Govt. of Odisha was organised with a sponsored amount of Rs.4,00,000 (Rupees Four Lakhs only) to promote cultural, social and sports activities among students.
